POSITION OVERVIEW:

This position will assist in coaching the co-op football program with Mound Westonka . The Assistant Football Coach assists in providing leadership and supervision for the team and works closely with the other coaching staff. Position participates in conducting practices, motivation of students, and instructing athletes in game strategies and techniques to prepare them for competition.

Position Duties, Responsibilities, and Expectations:

- Participates in practice sessions that are both stimulating and instructive, conducted on a regular basis with the goal of developing the athlete's greatest potential; teaches basic fundamental skills of football.
- Responsible for communication with the players and parents regarding expectations, schedules, etc.
- Oversees equipment and systematic return of all equipment at the finish of each session and season.
- Works with the athletics director in scheduling facilities for practices and competition.
- Coaches and instructs students, individually or in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, equipment, and techniques of the sport.
- Observes students, during competition and practice to determine the needs for individual or team improvement.
- Participates in special activities to include parent's night, banquets, and award nights.
- Assigns duties to an assistant coach as necessary.
- Attend coaches' meetings as assigned by Athletic Director.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Prior experience as a coach or assistant coach; preferably in the sport of football.
- Demonstrated ability to assess player's skills, monitors players during competition and practice.
- Demonstrates solid organizational skills and ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing; maintain effective working relationships with school staff, parents, and students.
- Must possess a thorough knowledge of the rules, regulations, strategies, and techniques of the sport.
- Ability to be flexible with schedule for practices and games.
- Models sports-like behavior and maintains appropriate conduct towards students, officials, and spectators.
- Possess strong Christian faith with demonstrated character of integrity and personal reference. Holds a solid knowledge of God's Word with a growing personal relationship in Jesus Christ.
