POSITION OVERVIEW:

This person is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the girls’ softball program. Qualified candidate must fully support the mission and vision of Southwest Christian High School (SWCHS) and the Athletics philosophy.

Position Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide a vision for the girls’ softball program:
 - Develop team expectations through handbook and other communications
 - Develop summer training and off-season conditioning program
 - Develop plan to involve lower-level coaches and programs
- Coaching and related administrative duties:
 - Participates in practice sessions that are both stimulating and instructive, conducted on a regular basis with the goal of developing the athlete’s greatest potential; teaches fundamental skills of softball.
 - Coaches and instructs students, individually or in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, equipment, and techniques of the sport; follows MSHSL requirements.
 - Observes students, during competition and practice to determine the need for individual or team improvement; provide necessary feedback.
 - Responsible for communication with the players and parents regarding expectations, schedules, etc.
 - Works with the Athletic Director in scheduling facilities for practices and competition.
 - Participates in special activities to include parents’ night, banquets, and award nights.
 - Oversees equipment and systematic return of all equipment at the finish of each session and season.
 - Assigns duties to an assistant coach as necessary.
 - Attend coaches’ meetings as assigned by Athletic Director.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Previous head coaching or extensive assistant coaching experience at the high school level or higher.
 - Demonstrated ability to assess player’s skills, monitors players during competition and practice.
 - Demonstrates solid organizational skills and ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing; maintain effective working relationships with school staff, parents, and students.
 - Must possess a thorough knowledge of the rules, regulations, strategies, and techniques of softball.
- Ability to be flexible with schedule for practices and games.
- Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions toward others including students, officials, and spectators
 - Possess strong Christian faith with demonstrated character of integrity and personal reference. Holds a solid knowledge of God’s Word with a growing personal relationship in Jesus Christ.
